


Under NSF support, Cliff Mass and his group have been actively studying the 2023 Maui wildfire, with the first results described in an [accepted article](#) in the journal, *Weather and Forecasting*. This paper showed that high-resolution modeling could skillfully predict the development of the strong winds and that a nearby hurricane had little impact. Continued research will examine the historical and future trends in the conditions that produced the fire, as well as its predictability.
